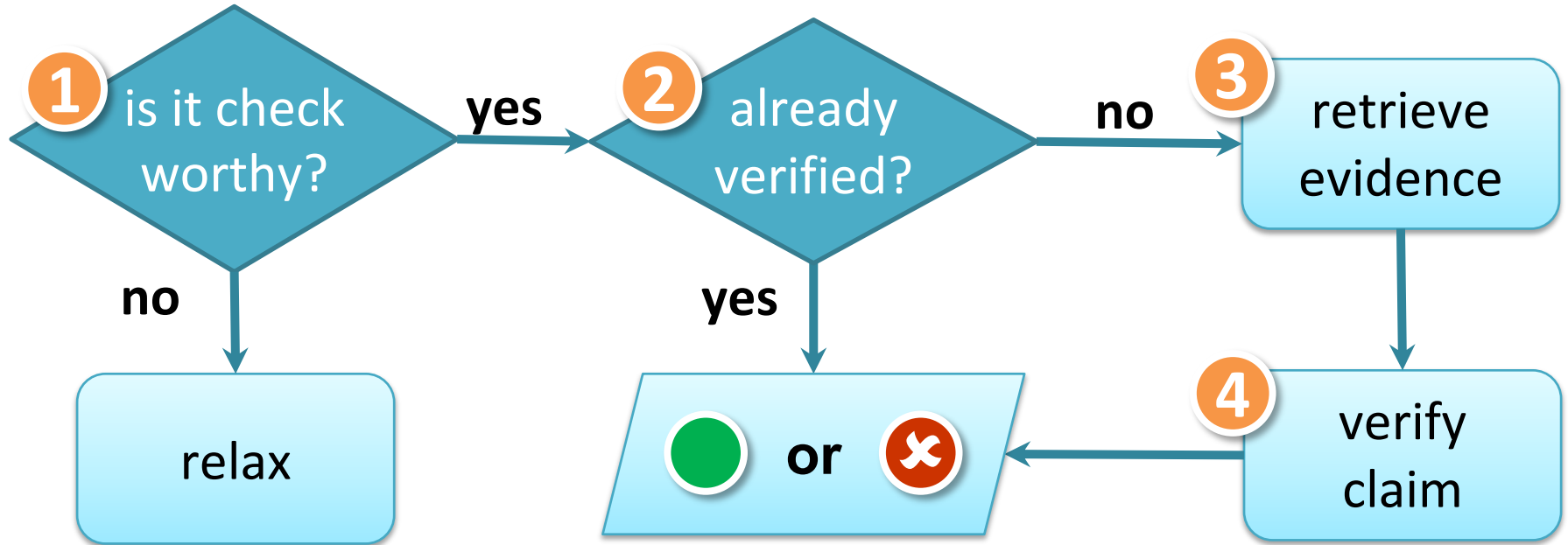

4 tasks to rule them all




1 Check-Worthiness

Predict which  in a **Twitter stream** contains a claim worth fact-checking.

(+ task 5 on debates)




3 Evidence Retrieval

Given a  and a list of **Web pages**, retrieve passages useful for verification.




2 Verified Claim Retrieval

Given a , and a set of **previously verified claims**, determine whether the tweet's claim has been verified.



4 Claim Verification

Given a  and a set of **Web pages/passages**, estimate the veracity of the claim.

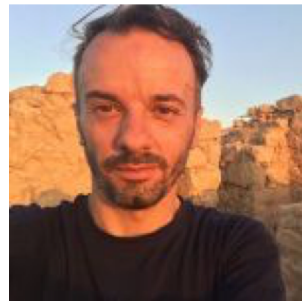
